Desserts

D A large selection of desserts will be available to choose from on the evening (the dessert menu is created by the chefs daily)

The attractive village of Rushton is en-route home to Market Harborough from Warkton. The route home avoids the A14 and the closed section of the A6

To get to Warkton The village is small with one loop road and the church prominent.

From Market Harborough. Take the A6 south from the MH bypass roundabout at Great Bowden. The A6 is closed at Desborough so at the first roundabout take the B576 - the old A6 - through Desborough and Rothwell which then merges with the A14. After 2 miles exit the A14 junction for Stamford. At the top of the slip road turn left onto the A43. After 2 miles take the 2nd exit at the roundabout onto the A4300. After 1 ½ miles turn right at the little roundabout. The road goes through Weekley; the turn for **Warkton** is on the left shortly after Weekley

To get to Rushton from Warkton

Return to the A43 and continue on the A43 towards Corby. After 1 ½ miles at the major roundabout take the first exit towards Oakham, after 40 yards go under the railway bridge and then after another 40 yards turn Left. This brings you to Rushton. The Thornhill Arms is on a corner overlooking the cricket ground and church.
